Dear Parents,
Enclosed are your child's Iowa Tests of Basic Skills (ITBS) results. We are thrilled with the strong results and the high academic performance of the CHA students. The overall test results verify that we are a school of excellence.

This year marks a new endeavor as students completed the ITBS online instead of the paper-based model previously. While the test questions and answers remained the same as the previous test, the testing process was a new experience for students. Included below are the results for comparison year over year for 2019, 2022 and 2023. The test was not administered from 2020 to 2021. Riverside Insights, the publisher of the ITBS has also added a National Stanine Score which is included below. All scores are compared to 2017 national norms. The comparison year is determined by Riverside Insight. Previous to 2017, the national norm was compared to the results from 2011. A National Stanine score became available in 2022 and will be included as a comparison on going. The Complete Composite score includes English Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies, and Science.
