



Daily Health Check for Open Centers as of June 5, 2020

A Daily Health Check will be conducted on every person (all staff, families and children) entering the center:

1. TEMPERATURE CHECK:

A designated staff member will take the temperature of each person.

Any person with a fever of 100.4° F or above will not be permitted to enter.

2. SCREENING QUESTIONS:

Each person will be asked the following questions and any person/household who answers “**YES**” to ANY question will NOT be permitted to enter.

A. Do you or any member of your household:

- Fever of 100.4° F or greater now or in the preceding **72 hours**, (or would have, but have used fever reducing medicine) *
- Have a cough?
- Have a sore throat?
- Have any muscle aches?
- Have any difficulty breathing?
- New loss of taste or smell?

B. Your entire household needs to be in full compliance with our current COVID-19 policy.

- Please confirm that no one in your household has in the last 14 days:
 - Had a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19
 - Been tested, been advised to be tested or is awaiting test results for COVID-19 (regardless of the result)
 - Self-isolated or been directed to quarantine due to Covid-19
 - Travelled to a restricted area

Note: If a member of a household has been tested as part of a standard, scheduled testing protocol by their employer and not due to that individual’s symptoms or possible exposure: **THEN** the household will NOT be excluded, provided documentation of the testing policy has been submitted to the center - **UNLESS/UNTIL** a positive result is received

**Temperature threshold and additional questions may vary by state.*

SCREENING INSTRUCTIONS FOR STAFF CONDUCTING DAILY HEALTH CHECK

1. Bring a change of clothing
2. Hand hygiene- wash/disinfect hands
3. Wear mask
4. Wear gloves
5. Taking Temperatures:
 - a. If using NON-CONTACT thermometers:
 - gloves do not need to be changed between individuals
 - thermometer DOES need to be cleaned after each individual
 - b. If using Ear Thermometers:
 - gloves DO need to be changed between each individual
 - thermometer DOES need to be cleaned after each individual
6. Discard gloves and covers in covered trash bin
7. Hand hygiene – wash hands often
8. Launder clothing or place potentially contaminated clothing into a sealed bag
