

## Introduction to Elementary Math Competition (2nd - 4th grade)



This is an introductory class to math competition in elementary school. Students will work on problems from real contests and learn math problem-solving techniques. Competition is one of the most effective ways to learn math. There will be a Q&A for the parents at the end of semester who want their children to explore further in this path.

We will use problems from Math Kangaroo (<http://www.mathkangaroo.us/mk/default.html>) and Math is Cool (<https://www.academicsarecool.com/#/home>) in this class.
