Grade 2

Composite Grade Equivalent Average – 4.0 (Fourth grade, 0 month)
Composite National School Norm Percentile Ranking – 99%

Grade 3

Composite Grade Equivalent Average – 5.8 (Fifth grade 8th month)
Composite National School Norm Percentile Ranking – 99%

Grade 4

Composite Grade Equivalent Average – 7.1 (Seventh grade, 1st month)
Composite National School Norm Percentile Ranking – 99%

Grade 5

Composite Grade Equivalent Average – 8.9 (Eighth grade, 8th month)
Composite National School Norm Percentile Ranking -- 99%
